- Creation of instructional material(s) for all technology offers for students, staff, and faculty.
- Provides online analytics for all web-based services.
- Administers and enforces college wide adherence to college and regulatory agencies policies regarding all functions that are directly under their control.
- Develops policies and procedures regarding all functions that are directly under their control.
- Continued maintenance of the college's annual digital catalog.
- Creates and maintains content for the college's digital signage.
- Keeps current regarding technology issues and utilizes this knowledge in performance of duties.
- Travels and represents the college as requested by the Chief Information Officer.
