EXPLORE

You have completed 12-30 credit hours. It is time to answer these questions and complete these tasks:

- Have you selected a program of study for your bachelor's degree?
- Do your major and your career aspirations match? Talk with [Career Development](#) to learn more.
- Have you researched 4-year institutions that offer your degree? What are your top 3 colleges?: _____

- Have you attended a T3 event, transfer fair or talked with the transfer institution recruiter/representative?
- Are online studies or on-campus studies the right choice for you?

- Do you know what documents you need to apply to your transfer school (college/high school transcripts, ACT scores, AP)?
- Have you requested an admissions packet from the universities you plan to apply to?

ACT

You have completed 46-60 credit hours. You have Explored and Planned. Now it is time to ACT! These are your next steps to successful transfer to your university:

- Meet with your [EGCC Advisor](#) to make sure you are on track for graduation.
- Meet with your future university advisor. What do you need to do now?
- Complete all appropriate paperwork (application, financial aid, scholarships, etc.) for your university.
- Request all necessary documents that need to be sent to your university (transcripts, ACT, AP, etc.) and send them.
- Pay any required application fees.
- Follow-up with your university advisor after applying. Make sure everything is in place and received and that you are on-track. Check your application status frequently!
- [Graduate](#) from EGCC! YAY! Send all final transcripts to your new university.
- Be sure to attend any orientations and complete ALL necessary enrollment requirements for your new university!
