

Viewing Your Progress

There are several ways within your courses to see how you are doing. One way is within the Path. If you have taken an assessment, you will see that it either still needs grading or your grade on it. To do this, find the assessment within the Path that you want to see and click on that assessment. You will see your evaluation of that assessment on the right-hand side of the page.

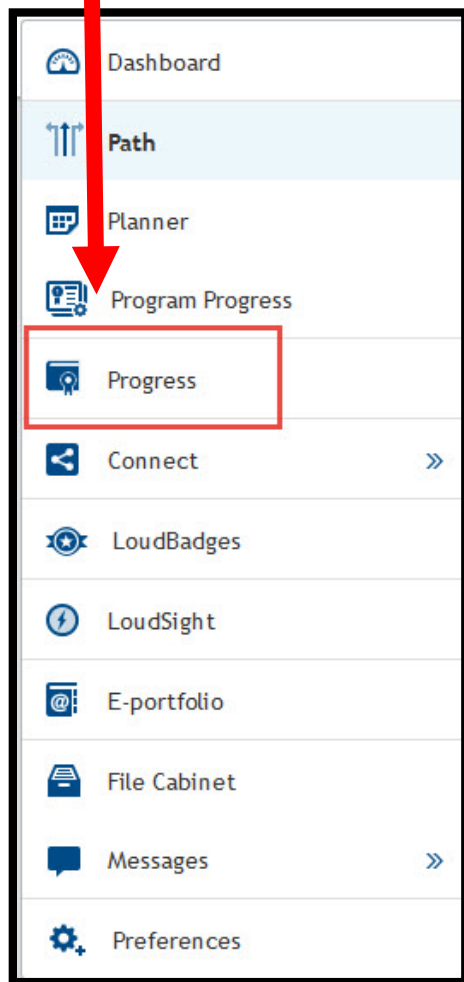
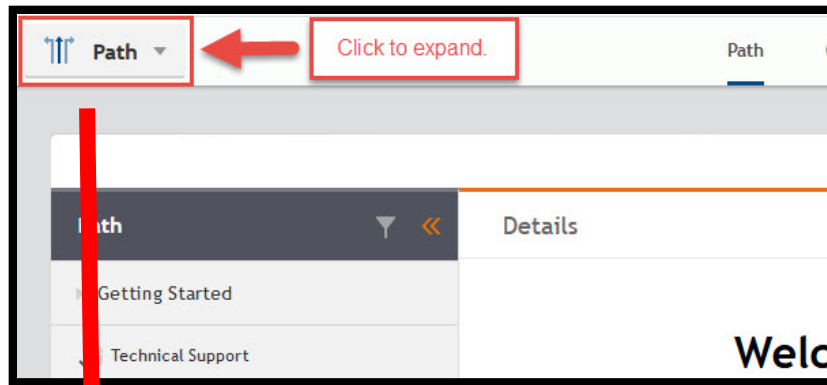

Here, you can view your attempts and, if you have multiple attempts, take the assessment again. For assignments, if an instructor reassigned it back to you, you will also access it here.

The second way to view your grades is in Progress. This will allow you to see all of your assessments along with its grade and feedback all in one place. To access Progress, use the drop-down navigation on the left. Since you are on the Path, it will say Path at the top of the drop-down. Click on it and it will expand for you to see Progress.



Once you are on Progress, you be directed to your 'My Grades' tab and will see all the assessments in the Path listed on the left-hand side. Next to each assessment, you will see when it was due (if there is a due date), when you submitted it, the grade you made, and any comments or feedback from your instructor.

If you click on the assessment title, you will be directed to that area of the Path, so you can either take it again or view the results. Other tags within Progress is 'Missed' if you missed a due date, 'Late' if you turned your assessment in late, and 'Reassign' if the instructor is allowing you to turn in your assignment again. You can also download your grades.

If the assessments within your course are aligned to learning objectives, you will also see 'My Achievements' tab. This will show you how well you are doing on each learning objective. As with the 'My Grades' tab, you can also download this page.
