Eastern Gateway Community College invites applications for a term contract instructor position for its Pharmacy Technician program. This position will work under the direct and indirect supervision of the Director of Workforce & Community Outreach and the Pharmacy Program Manager. The location of this position is on the Youngstown campus of Eastern Gateway Community College.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES:

This position will instruct students using standardized curriculum, review lesson plans and prepare for class instruction, grade and electronically record assignments, actively promote student retention, support externship activities as applicable, clinical evaluations and perform related work as required.
