**\*\*Drops and Withdrawals** will be processed according to Eastern Gateway Community College’s policy. If a dual credit student drops a class within the first two weeks of the regular semester, the Business Office will refund the district and the student will not be held liable for repayment. After this time frame has expired, all schedule changes up to the 10-week mark are considered a **“withdraw”** and are not subject to refunds. The grade of **“W”** is recorded as zero hours earned and zero quality points. The dual credit student may also be held liable for repayment to their school district.
