The Senior Technology Specialist works in a team environment to ensure that the computers and network systems are responsible, reliable, secure, and effectively support teaching, learning, and administrative services at the College. This position will be based at our campus in Steubenville, Ohio.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Diagnoses, troubleshoots, and repairs computer and network systems and hybrid cloud environments.
- Provides technical leadership and assistance to Technology Support Specialists, ensuring the timely and efficient maintenance and repair of all computer network and telecommunications systems.
- Maintains an accurate inventory of all computers, projectors, classroom technologies, and other electronic systems.
- Performs routine computer services, data entry, and backups.
- Makes equipment and repair recommendations.
- Provides first level support as needed, including phone, on-site and remote assistance.
- Monitors computers and network systems for basic faults as well as advanced alarms to ensure performance and continuing operations.
- Ability to interpret alarm logs and other system data for proactive fault management.
- Maintains up-to-date knowledge of current and emerging technology.
- Participates in departmental meetings, in service training and other activities as required; attends conferences, seminars, and professional meetings as required.
- After-hour, on-call support may be required.
- Travel to other locations may be required on occasion.
- Other job-related duties as assigned.

- Five (5) years related experience in desktop/server, network systems management and troubleshooting over a wide area network.
