Hello Potential Applicant,

Thank you for your interest in the Veterinary Technology program here at Eastern Gateway Community College. This packet has been designed to assist you in navigating the application process. Inside you will find a checklist of program prerequisite courses, a field experience form, and a background check form. Please note there are 13 credits of required prerequisites which must be completed and a grade posted in CampusCloud before your application can be considered. You must also complete a minimum of 40 hours of field experience which can include shadowing/volunteering at a veterinary clinic/hospital, large animal farm/facility, and/or animal shelter. However, applicants are encouraged to complete as many field experience hours as possible. A background check is also required.

Please copy the completed and signed field experience form, returning one copy to your enrollment specialist and the other copy to the Office of the Dean of Health Sciences and Public Services (rriska@egcc.edu). For applicants interested in potentially starting in the Fall of 2021, all prerequisites and forms must be completed and submitted by August 5, 2021. For applicants interested in potentially starting in the Spring of 2022, all prerequisites and forms must be completed and submitted by December 10, 2021.

As seen in the attached course grid, our curriculum is both rigorous and varied. Courses are offered in companion, large, and exotic animals with an emphasis on all aspects of companion animal care. We are pleased to partner with Angels for Animals, 4750 South Range Rd., Canfield, OH, 44406. Angels for Animals has a beautiful state-of-the-art facility including a shelter/adoption center, spay and neuter services, a full-service veterinary clinic including several operating theaters, and classrooms.
