Please know that your diploma will be ordered after all grades from your last semester are posted, and the Dean of your program provides final approval. Diplomas may take 6 to 8 weeks to arrive via mail to your address on file with the college once the college places the order. Please make sure your address is up to date, as we will use the address you have on file with the Registrar's office. Your EGCC transcript will also be updated at this time to reflect a graduate status and an official copy of your transcript can be ordered through the [National Student Clearinghouse](#) link. The transcript is the document that institutions and employers request for graduate verification.
