The course load of a student may not exceed 18 semester credit hours of course work in a regular semester (16 weeks) or 9 semester credit hours of course work in an accelerated semester (8 weeks) without the approval of the department dean. While 12 credits are required in any semester to meet the Title IV regulatory definition of Full Time, given the Summer semester's shorter length, EGCC views 6 credits taken in the Summer 8-week semester to be the academic equivalent of Full **Time.** The maximum per session is as follows: First Eight Weeks = 9 credit

hours, Last Eight Weeks = 9 credit hours, and Sixteen Weeks – 18 credit hours.
