McCloud: I'm worried about engagement. On the FB page, I asked students about their issues. I think this would be a great idea if it would get engagement, but we can still try it. When I was active on the Instagram, I would ask there but didn't get anything. Some concerns I got on FB were:

- Shipping costs from Print Shop
- People want more updates from Geoghegan and HLC

Cooper: Prior to CSU with not knowing whats going on, that's exactly what we're for. We can actually find this kind of information out and look into.

McCloud: Student mentioned in comment said she reached out and CSU never responded, and it was right around the time the FCB thing happened.

Cooper: We have a lot of connections here. It might not be something we look at right now, but maybe in the future. It was a big problem. I think we do need to do the survey, not every student is aware that we have social media, and we need to find a way to engage students.

McCloud: I know there are people that don't want to talk about it because it's upsetting. A subcommittee can come up with the questions and go through the answers.

Richards: CSU not responding is an important concern. Nothing against EGCC, but before coming here, I was concerned about being taken seriously trying to go to another school.

McCloud: I don't know how we can fix CSU's problems but we can try to reach out.

McCloud: There were documents sent out by an anonymous professor but I don't know what they say yet. We can try to get a hold of those, but I haven't seen anything other than what's been published.

McCloud: When will the Discord be ready?

Twyford: By Monday. I will send a link for people to join.

Richards gave an explanation of what Discord is and how we can use it.
