Christina stated that there are no current updates about the Free College Program. Rebecca discussed two types of students, degree seeking students and transient students. Transient students are completing course work at two institutions. They can still receive financial aid, but the process is a little different. For the Free College benefit program to cover your costs you must be a degree seeking student. (per Title IV). Students who have already completed a degree program at EGCC may register for classes for second degree program. For those who are not paying out of pocket, complete the 23-24 school year FAFSA forms. Professor Spindler also suggested that it might be helpful for students to have a Financial Aid Night. Maybe a prerecorded session. The meeting could cover work study and different types of loans.

Conclusions:

Apply now for school year 23-24 financial aid. There are no updates for the Free College Benefit Program. Financial Aid Night for PTK members would be better suited later in the evening.
